Attached, please find the word lists A and B of words your child must learn this year. These are sight words. They do not have to be spelled, however, your child must say them correctly when the teacher points to the word. List A must be mastered by the first week in December 2008. List B must be mastered by the last week in April 2009. The best method to work on the words might be to write them on word cards, then take a few each week to learn until your child knows them all quickly by sight. The State of Oklahoma mandates individualized testing be administered to all First Graders. You can really help your child by working on these words. We are also working on them at school, but it is usually not enough exposure to all of the words for your child if they do not work on them at home as well. Thank you for your help and support in behalf of your child.
